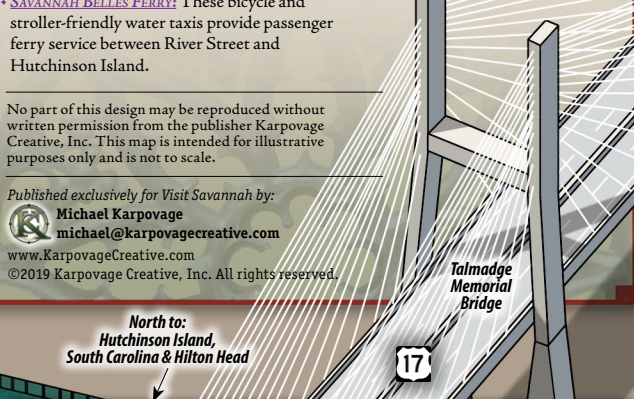

- Savannah's Downtown Transportation System (dot) connects visitors via two express shuttle loops and water ferries - FREE of charge. Runs every 10 minutes!
- dot Express Forsyth Loop Shuttle
- dot Express Downtown Loop Shuttle
- dot Water Taxi Route
- EXPRESS SHUTTLES Get on and off at any of 24 stops around the Historic District via two shuttle loops. Connects to municipal parking facilities, Ferry, and Visitor Centers.
- SAVANNAH BELLES FERRY These bicycle and stroller-friendly water taxis provide passenger ferry service between River Street and Hutchinson Island.
